WHO WE ARE

Our History

In the fall of 1996, the General Manager of Station Mont Tremblant and then Vice-President of Intrawest, Mr. Roger McCarthy, was struck by the reality that in the Mont-Tremblant region, children were arriving at school without having eaten and with no lunchbox. Some students lacked access to local sports, while others were unable to develop their talents due to financial constraints.

He partnered with Ms. Thérèse Barrette to coordinate what would become Fondation Tremblant. Together with community members committed to the well-being of local youth, they began recruiting members for the Board of Directors. The Board held its first meeting on November 29, 1996, and Fondation Tremblant was officially registered with the Quebec business registry on January 24, 1997, quickly turning Mr. McCarthy's vision into reality.

By spring 1997, Fondation Tremblant held its first annual auction, raising over \$100,000 for children. This successful event has been repeated annually ever since

TRIBUTE TO OUR FOUNDERS

The year 2025 was marked by the passing of our two founders: Roger McCarty passed away in January 2025, and Ms. Thérèse Barrette joined him at the end of July.

A visionary and builder, Roger McCarty played a decisive role in the development of Station Mont Tremblant, which he led with passion and conviction. Under his leadership, Tremblant experienced remarkable growth, becoming an internationally renowned destination while maintaining a strong connection to its community.

Roger was not only a business leader—he was a deeply compassionate individual who believed in the power of mutual support and community engagement. In 1996, driven by a desire to help local children and families, he founded **Fondation Tremblant**—an inspiring initiative that continues to make a real difference today.

His vision, integrity, and genuine attachment to the region left a lasting impression on all who had the privilege of knowing him. Thanks to him, Tremblant became much more than a mountain—it became a close-knit, supportive community focused on the future.

Thank you, Roger, for your leadership, generosity, and invaluable legacy.

A strong and determined woman, and above all a woman of great heart, Thérèse Barrette left her mark on our beautiful region.

Nearly 30 years ago, she stood alongside Roger McCarty in the creation of Fondation Tremblant, where she served as coordinator for more than 16 years. It is thanks to their shared vision and deep desire to improve the lives of local children that the Foundation is what it is today.

Thérèse also served as Executive Director of the Saint-Jovite (later Mont-Tremblant) Chamber of Commerce for 16 years and spent 12 years as a municipal councillor for the City of Mont-Tremblant.

A remarkable woman, she devoted her life to advancing Mont-Tremblant. She leaves an indelible mark on the hearts of all who knew her.

Thank you, Thérèse. Thank you for everything.

OUR IMPACT

Call for Projects

For the first time, the 2024–2025 call for projects was extended over a two-month period, from August 15 to October 15, 2024, giving registered charities, schools, and municipalities more time to submit their projects (up to three projects per organization). A committee then proceeded with the analysis of the applications. Each project is reviewed individually and in the context of all submitted projects in order to make recommendations to the Board of Directors regarding the allocation of funds.

During the 2024 call for projects, 54 organizations submitted 106 projects, with total funding requests reaching nearly \$1.1 million.

Grant Distribution

On Friday, December 13, 2024, Fondation Tremblant held its annual grant distribution as part of the 24h Tremblant festivities. Beneficiary organizations were invited to Base Camp Tremblant to receive their official letters confirming their grants and the acceptance of their projects for the current year.

\$700,000 was distributed to **51 organizations**

to fund **92 projects** across the MRC des Laurentides.

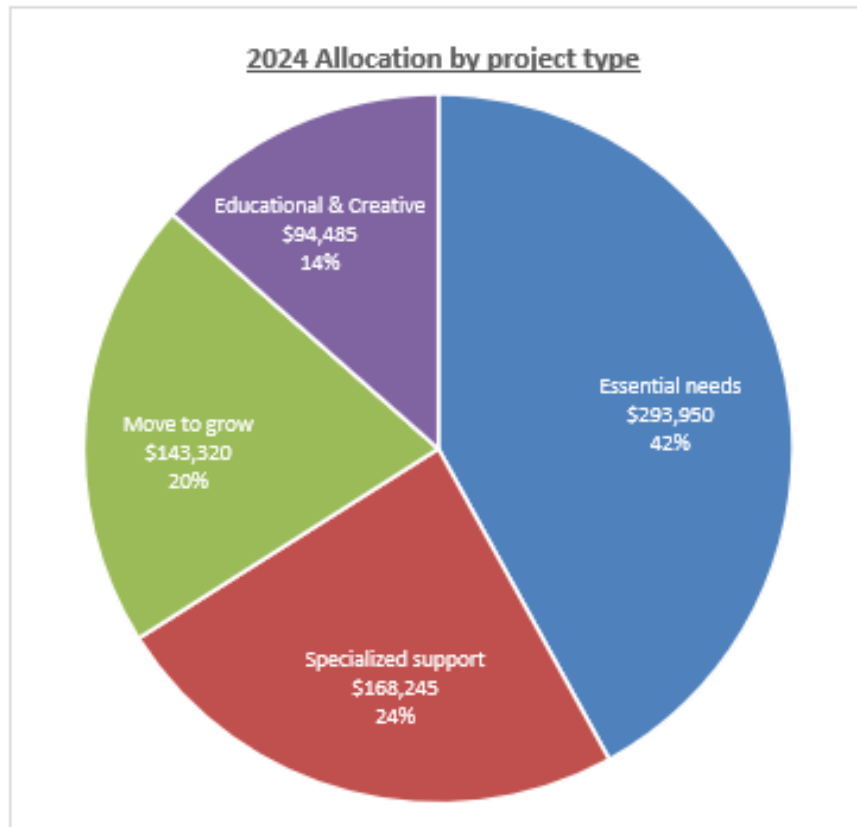

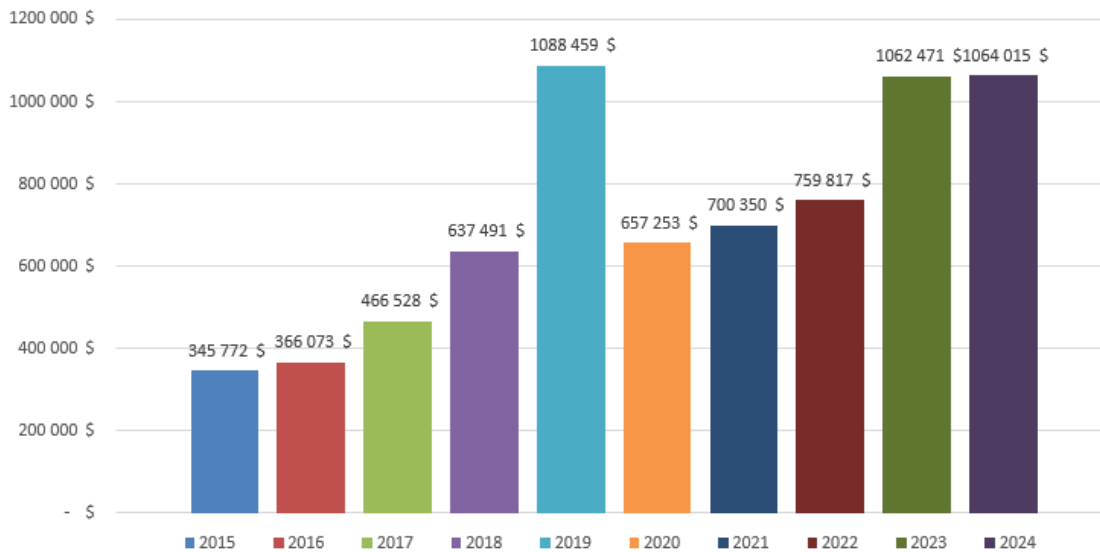

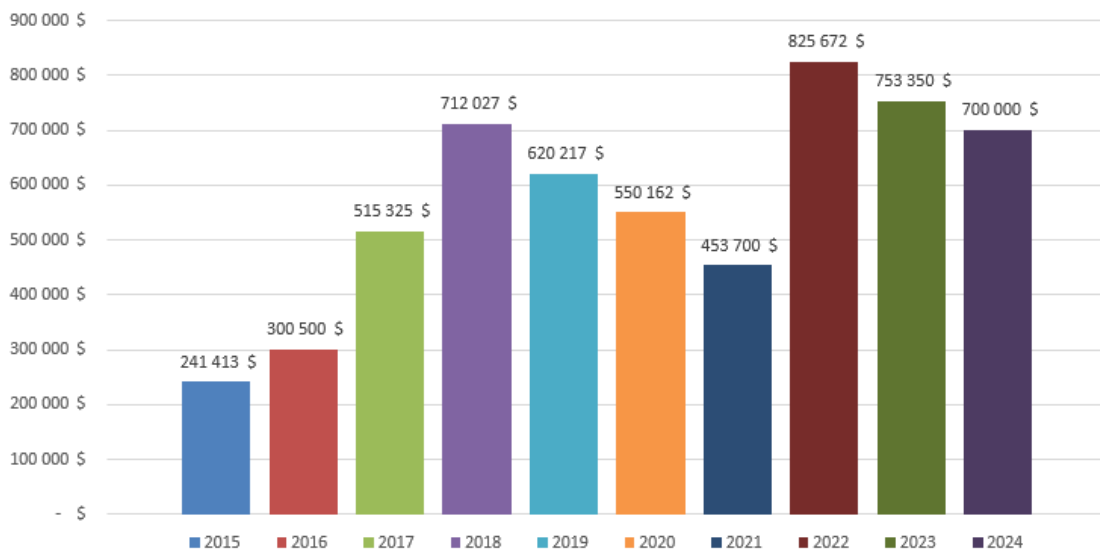

Evolution of Donation Allocated Since 2015, including regular and special donations

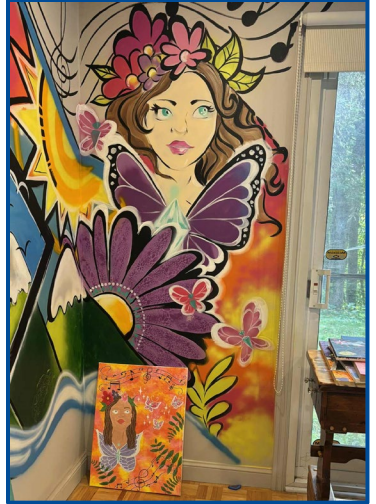

The Event and its Mission

The Fondation 24h Tremblant supports children's causes by providing funding to medical and social organizations with the ultimate goal of seeing all children flourish and lead healthy lives.

It provides financial support to its beneficiary foundations to help them meet the needs of children with physical or mental illnesses and impairments, special needs, or who are living in disadvantaged areas.

Tremblant's 24h is Quebec #1 winter sport challenge. Starting on Saturday at noon until Sunday at noon, teams of 6 to 12 participants relay each other for 24 consecutive hours either skiing, snowboarding, alpine touring, walking, or running. In the weeks leading up to the event, participants undertake a donation drive from which all profits go to five important foundations dedicated to children's causes, including Fondation Tremblant

Our 2 Sponsored Children

Each year, Fondation Tremblant has the privilege of sponsoring two young individuals during the event. These youths become the face of the cause, representing the Foundation.

Abby, age 9, lives with Gaucher disease and juvenile arthritis, which bring challenges such as vision problems, shortness of breath, pulmonary complications, and persistent fatigue, in addition to chronic pain.

In her daily life, Abby faces limitations in her movements and often experiences a level of fatigue far greater than that of her peers. Despite this, she shows remarkable perseverance. At school, she benefits from adapted equipment, including a specialized desk, chair, and computer, allowing her to remain in a regular third-grade classroom.

Thanks to Fondation Tremblant, Abby receives support through an accompaniment service at day camp, enabling her to participate in activities alongside other children her age.





Mélodie, 16, has been living since the age of 6 with Autism Spectrum Disorder, generalized anxiety disorder, and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.

School remains a major challenge for Mélodie, even though she is enrolled in a specialized class at Polyvalente des Monts with other students also living with autism.

A student café project partially funded by Fondation Tremblant, the “T’Sa coche Café,” allows Mélodie and other youth on the autism spectrum to develop skills that will help them integrate into the workforce.

The Family Zone

During the Tremblant’s 24h weekend, Fondation Tremblant, along with the four other beneficiary foundations, welcomed participants and visitors to its tent in the Family Zone. Activities included crafts, a challenge wheel, and a slideshow showcasing funded projects and organizations.
